



## Sanctions Policy Statement

In addition to violations of the basic rules of golf etiquette, aggressive behavior, hostility or physical force directed toward staff or other players is not permitted. As well, verbal or sexual abuse of staff or players will not be tolerated. This includes acts or comments that are known, or ought to be known, to be unwelcome, embarrassing, offensive, threatening or degrading to another person.

Sanctions may be applied to members, guests or staff members who violate these rules or the rules of golf etiquette. Sanctions will be appropriate to the violation and may include, but are not limited to the following: verbal reprimand, written reprimand, suspension of playing and/or cart privileges, or expulsion from the club. Any complaints about misbehavior must be made in writing, signed and directed to the attention of the Board of Directors. Section 19 of the Club By-laws states: "Any member may be suspended or expelled from the Club for unseemly conduct upon a vote of three quarters of all the directors in a meeting duly called for such purpose. Such member shall be entitled to prior written notification of the particulars of the conduct, the date and location of such meeting and the right to make representations thereat".
