



## 2020 "Safe Play" Measures Release #3

**Face Masks are now mandatory in all Club buildings, including the Pro Shop, Clubhouse and locker rooms and washrooms.**

### **Cleaning, Sanitation and Safety**

- The frequency of routine cleaning, sanitation and disinfection of all locations, especially all common and high traffic areas and high touch surfaces has been expanded.
- The frequency of routine cleaning and disinfecting of Clubhouse and on-course washroom facilities has been expanded.
- Club Power carts, including keys, and pull carts will be cleaned and sanitized before each use.
- Appropriate signage and guidelines have been installed.

### **Booking a Tee Time**

- All players must have a pre-booked tee time.
- Tee-times may only be booked through the online Tee-On system or by phone with the Pro Shop.
- Guest are encouraged to pre-pay their green fees using the Tee-On online payment option. If payment needs to be made in the Pro Shop, we encourage touchless electronic payment methods.
- All non-member players, must supply valid contact information including full name, telephone number or email address.

### **In the Pro Shop**

- Only 2 patrons may be present in the Pro Shop at one time.
- Follow the defined one-way ENTER and EXIT guides.
- Hand sanitation is available upon entry and at exit.
- Golf club rentals are not be available until further notice.
- The Golf Canada Score Center computer kiosk has been removed. Scores are to be posted from your home computer, phone or other device.
- Bulk scorecards and pencils have been removed from the self-serve area in the Pro Shop. Please request scorecards and pencils in the Pro Shop or from the Starter at the first tee.

### **Washroom facilities**

- Men's and women's washrooms are open but access to lockers will be restricted.
- Golfers are to enter and exit washrooms via the outside doors only. Access to washrooms for patrons of the restaurant is available via the internal Clubhouse stairs
- Face coverings must be worn when inside Clubhouse washrooms.
- On-course facilities are available on Hole # 3 & Hole #10.

### **On the Course**

- All bunker rakes have been removed.
- Ball washers are not in service.
- Benches have been removed from the course.
- Flagsticks will remain in the hole – do not remove them or touch them in any way.
- Raised cup liners will be in use which will limit the necessity to touch the cup when removing the ball.
- Please respect the designated "Pick-Up" and "Drop-Off" areas for power carts and pull carts. Do not remove keys from power carts.

### **Power Cart Usage**

- Safety Dividers have been installed in all power carts.
- Riders who are from the same household or in the same social bubble may elect to use the safety dividers in the "rolled-up" position.
- Safety dividers must remain in the "down" position for all other riders.

### **Food and Beverage Service**

- Food and beverage services are offered through our independent restaurant operators. Please follow all direction given, including signage for entry, exit and movement in the Clubhouse.
- Service is now available in the Clubhouse dining room and lounge, and on the outdoor deck and patio.
- Face coverings must be worn when inside the Clubhouse. Coverings may be removed once seated inside the restaurant or once outside on the deck/patio.
- Tables have been arranged and spaced as per health and safety regulations. Please do not move them. Do not add additional seating to tables.
- Take-out service is also available. Face coverings are mandatory when take-out orders are picked up.
- On-course food and beverage services are available at the Halfway BBQ and from the food and beverage cart.

### **Player's Commitment**

- If you are unwell, stay home. Any players exhibiting any signs of illness will not be permitted to play and will be asked to leave the property.
- You may not access the Club property if you have recently arrived home from outside of the country and have not completed the mandatory 14 day quarantine.
- Non-member guests are required to supply valid contact information when booking tee-times.
- We encourage you to bring your own face masks, sanitation and wipes.
- Do not arrive more than 20 minutes before your tee time. Stay in or near your car until the Starter calls you to the first tee.
- Follow all communication given by the Starter.
- Practise physical distancing at all times. Please stay at least 2 club lengths apart on the tee, on the fairway, on the green and on the pathways.
- Do not look for or pick up golf balls that are not yours.
- Smooth bunkers as best you can with your foot or wedge.
- For continued safety, and to speed up play, players may wish to putt out one at a time.
- Do not exchange or attest scorecards. Confirm scores verbally with other players.
- Do not leave garbage or litter of any kind on the course or in power carts. Use the receptacles provided or pack out all your garbage and recycling and dispose at home.
- Respect your safety and the safety of others at all times.
