



COVID-19 Update April 3, 2020

At Picton Golf & Country Club, the health, well-being and safety of our members, guests and staff are a priority. The COVID-19 pandemic is a fluid situation and we continue to review all the changes, updates and recommendations from our government and health officials and how they apply to our Club.

Picton Golf & Country Club is temporarily closed under the provisions set out in the Ontario Government's closure of non-essential businesses. The initial mandatory closure has been updated and is currently in effect until April 18. We expect the government will issue another update on or before this date.

While we know that everyone is anxious for answers, to avoid any decisions being made with erroneous or out of dates information, we are implementing only those plans that can be established using current information.

Previous government authorization allows golf courses to carry out essential and necessary on-course work during the closures. This means that once non-essential closure restrictions are lifted, we will be in a better position to prepare to open the course for play.

We are looking ahead into future plans that deal with on course precautions and safety measures. We will be better equipped to make these decisions and build plans as we get through the next few weeks.

These are challenging times for all of us. We will continue to provide updates as new information becomes available.
