



2021 Safe Play Measures #1

Release Date: April 14, 2021

COVID-19 Safety and Restrictions continue to be a major focus for the 2021 Golf Season.

The regular routine cleaning, sanitation and disinfection of all locations, especially all common and high traffic areas, high touch surfaces areas at the Club, including in the Pro Shop, Clubhouse, all washroom facilities and power and hand carts, will continue according to recommended COVID safety guidelines.

The following protocols have been established to ensure the safety of all our members, guests and staff and to comply with all government and public health orders.

PLAYER'S COMMITMENT

- If you are unwell, stay home. Players exhibiting any signs of illness will not be permitted to play and will be asked to leave the property.
- You may not access the Club property if you have recently travelled outside of the country and have not completed the mandatory 14 day quarantine or have been in contact with anyone in the past 14 days who exhibits symptoms of COVID, has been diagnosed with COVID or who is under quarantine.
- Non-member guests are required to supply valid contact information when booking tee-times.
- We encourage you to bring your own safety and sanitation equipment.
- Do not arrive more than 20 minutes before your tee time.
- Respect your safety and the safety of others at all times.

FACE COVERINGS

- Face coverings are mandatory in all Club buildings, including the Pro Shop, the Clubhouse, locker rooms and washrooms and anywhere else, including outside, when physical distancing of 2 metres cannot be maintained.

BOOKING A TEE TIME

- All players must have a pre-booked tee time.
- Tee-times may only be booked through the online Tee-On system or by phone with the Pro Shop.

- Guest are encouraged to pre-pay their green fees using the Tee-On online payment option. If payment needs to be made in the Pro Shop, we encourage touchless electronic payment methods.
- All players in all foursomes must be identified to the Pro Shop prior to tee-off.
- All non-member players must supply valid contact information including full name, telephone number or email address.

IN THE PRO SHOP

- Only 2 patrons may be present in the Pro Shop at one time.
- Follow the defined one-way ENTER and EXIT guides.
- Please use the hand sanitizer provided in the Pro Shop.
- Golf club rentals are not available until further notice.
- The Golf Canada Score Center computer kiosk has been removed. Scores are to be posted from your home computer, phone or other device.
- Bulk scorecards and pencils have been removed from the self-serve area in the Pro Shop. Please request scorecards and pencils in the Pro Shop or from the Starter at the first tee.

WASHROOM FACILITIES

- Men's and women's locker rooms and washrooms in the Clubhouse are open.
- Golfers are to enter and exit washrooms via the outside doors only.
- Face coverings must be worn when inside Clubhouse washrooms.
- Access to lockers is restricted to seasonal renters only
- On-course facilities are available on Hole # 3 & Hole #10.

ON THE COURSE

- Follow all instructions given by the Starter at the 1st tee.
- Follow all instruction provided by on-course Marshals.
- Follow all signage posted.
- Practise physical distancing at all times. Please stay at least 2 club lengths apart on the tees, on the fairways, on the greens and on the pathways.
- All bunker rakes have been removed. Please smooth the bunkers as best you can with your foot or wedge.
- Ball washers are not in service.
- Flagsticks will remain in the hole – do not remove them or touch them in any way. Amendment to Rule 1.2b reads: ***Players are prohibited from touching or removing the flagstick. Blatant or repeated disregard for this safety measure may result in the suspension of golf privileges.***
- Cup liner inserts will be in use on all holes. These inserts prevent the ball from falling to the bottom of the cup and eliminate the necessity to touch the cup or flag when removing the ball. Rule 3.3 (Rules of Handicapping) will apply for scores posted for handicap purposes.

- Do not look for or pick up golf balls that are not yours.
- For continued safety, and to speed up play, players may wish to putt out one at a time.
- Do not exchange or attest scorecards. Confirm scores verbally with other players.
- Please respect the designated “Pick-Up” and “Drop-Off” areas for power carts and hand carts. Do not remove keys from power carts.

POWER CART USEAGE

- Face coverings must be worn by all players sharing a power cart unless they are from the same household. (as per April 2021 Ontario Government/Public Health restrictions.)

FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE

Food and beverage services are offered through our independent restaurant operators. Please follow all additional direction given, including signage for entry, exit and movement in the Clubhouse and at outside service areas.

- Dine-in food and beverage service is currently unavailable in the Clubhouse dining room and lounge and on the outdoor deck and patio.
- Take-out food and beverage service is available from the Clubhouse.
- Face coverings are mandatory when entering, exiting or when in transit inside the Clubhouse.
- On-course food and beverage service is available from the Hospitality Cart and at the Halfway BBQ area at Hole #10. Face coverings are mandatory when placing and picking up orders.
