



**The 2022
Club Championship Weekend
Friday – Saturday – Sunday
September 9, 10 & 11, 2022**

Championship Weekend will be held on September 9, 10. & 11th and offers a wide variety of fun for everyone, including competitive and non-competitive golf.

The fun starts on Friday September 9th with the annual Eric Reynolds Shoot-Out and culminates with the post celebration after the final shot of Championship Play is holed out mid-afternoon on Sunday September 12th. And with loads of great stuff in between!

Friday September 9

The Eric Reynolds Shoot-Out

Play commences at 3:00 pm and the field is limited to 40 players. Valid and up to date handicaps are required. Play will be flighted into “A” & “B” flights by handicap. Entry Fee is \$5.

How does the Shoot-Out work? Players tee off one after another on the same hole (“B” flight players start on Hole #2, “A” flight players start on Hole #1) and play until all balls are holed out. Highest scoring players are eliminated (number of players eliminated per hole is based on participation). Those surviving the cut move on the next hole. And so on, through 8 holes until there are just 4 players left in each flight. Play then moves to the 18th hole for the final shoot-out.

The Picton Calcutta

This Picton Golf Club tradition takes place immediately following the Shoot-Out and is open to all members and their significant others with an attendance maximum of 100. The event will be held on the deck/lower patio. In the event of rain, the event will be moved inside the Clubhouse.

This event is a much-anticipated highlight of the weekend, full of laughs and excitement, as virtual teams are “auctioned off” to the highest bidders. The teams are comprised of 4 Championship players (both men and women) from all flights so that talent and ability are all equalized as much as possible.

Bidders try to assess which team might have the best opportunity for one of its players to finish with the lowest individual net score on Saturday's Championship round. The player with the lowest net score wins that team's "owner" 50% of the pot. The player with the 2nd lowest net score wins that team's "owner" 30% of the pot. And the player with the 3rd lowest net score wins that team's "owner" 20% of the pot. Sound confusing? All will be explained in detail prior to the auction....

So, plan to come on out Friday evening about 5:30 pm to bid on your team and enjoy some complimentary appetizers. Then watch the players come in Saturday afternoon, cross your fingers, and hope one of your team players has the best game of the season! Be it strategic, crafty, or just plain luck, some of us might just take away a pot of "Picton Gold".

Championship Play - Saturday September 10 & Sunday September 11

Open to all members with valid and up to date handicaps. Tee times commence at 9:00am on Saturday and at approx. 10:00am on Sunday (right after the Recreational Division). Players play both days. Winners in all flights and overall Club Champion will be determined by cumulative gross scores for both days.

Men's Flights:

- A Flight – Hcp Index 0 – 8.9 (play is from the Blue Tees)
- B Flight – Hcp Index 9.0 – 15.5 (play is from the White Tees)
- C Flight – Hcp Index 15.6 – 20.1 (play is from the White Tees)
- D Flight – Hcp Index 20.2 and above (play is from the White Tees)

Women's Flights:

- A Flight – Course Hcp 0 – 20 (play is from the Red Tees)
- B Flight – Course Hcp 21 – 27 (play is from the Red Tees)
- C Flight – 28 and above (play is from the Red Tees)

Order of Play

Saturday: Women A-B-C, then Men A-B-C-D.

Sunday: Reverse order of flights, based on Saturday's results with the last groups consisting of the top 4 contenders in each flight.

Recreational Division – Sunday September 11

Want to be part of the action but don't have a valid handicap or are not interested in the 2-day Championship competition? Why not be part of this relaxed round on Sunday Morning. Tee times start at 9:00am and play is from your preferred tees.

Closest To The Hole Contests

Watch for the "Closest To The Hole" contests on both Saturday and Sunday for all players, including Championship Play golfers and Recreational Division golfers. These mini-contests are open to all players and will add some excitement to the rounds!

Fuel For The Game!

All players, both those competing in the Championship rounds and those playing in the Recreational Division, will be treated to some great food on Saturday and Sunday to keep them playing strong!

On Saturday, all players will receive a Hamburger, Sausage or Veggie Burger back at the Club immediately following the completion of the round. Please indicate your preference when signing up for Championship Play.

On Sunday, all players and cheering onlookers will be treated to complimentary BBQ pulled pork or pulled beef sandwiches, served on the lawn below the Clubhouse deck.
