



**Addendum to the Power Cart Policy  
Power Cart Safety Dividers  
“Use & Responsibility” Statement**

Following the approval for use by the Ontario Government and the Workplace Safety & Prevention Services (WSPS), safety dividers have been installed on all power carts. This will allow the shared use of power carts by all players, including those from separate households.

“Use & Responsibility” protocols and precautions are as follows:

- Riders from the same household or in the same social bubble may elect to ride in power carts with the safety divider in the “rolled-up” position.
- To be eligible to ride with the safety dividers in the “rolled-up” position, riders will be required to confirm their status (whether or not they reside in the same household or are in the same social bubble.)
- Dividers must remain in their “down” and installed position at all times for riders from separate households or those not in the same social bubble.

For those riding with dividers in the “down” position, the following protocols will apply:

- One occupant will be the designated driver, the other occupant will be the passenger. This designation must remain constant throughout the round and occupants may not switch roles.
- Occupants are to avoid shared touch points and should not handle each other’s golf equipment or personal effects.

Refusal to adhere to the above protocols may result in loss of power cart privileges.

Guest players who do not wish to share a power cart due to Covid-19 precautions may elect to be the sole occupant of the cart. In such instances, a surcharge of 50% of the single rider fee will be added to the cart fee.

Members who do not wish to share a power cart due to Covid-19 precautions are not subject to the additional surcharge.

Players assume all health and safety risks when using power carts.
