Pre-order your burgers, sausages or veggie burgers and pay at the Pro Shop. **Get your 50/50 Draw Tickets too!** Proceeds also benefit the food banks.

Here's how the "Plant Your Flag" game works:

All participants will receive a personalized Canadian flag at the first tee. The flag will have your name on it, along with your special "stroke number". For players with handicaps, the stroke number is "par + course handicap". For non-handicap players, randomly drawn numbers will be assigned. For non-handicap players, the random numbers will be between 25 and 35 for 18-hole players and 12 and 22 for 9-hole players.

Play your own game, totalling your strokes as you go, until your reach your stroke number. Plant your flag in the ground at this location! Of course, you can continue your round after planting your flag.

If you finish your game and have not used up all your strokes, proudly plant your flag on the hill behind 18th green (or behind the 9th green if playing 9 holes) and turn your scorecard in at the Pro Shop. Winners will be declared in both HCP and non-HCP flights.

Closest To The Hole Competition. Watch for the Closest To The Hole Competition too! Holes will be designated for both Men's and Women's contests.
